## May 20, 2020:

Fly from Pittsburgh to Glasgow.

#### May 21, 2020:

We will arrive into Glasgow and begin our journey north. The drive will take us along the Bonnie Banks of Loch Lomond to Inveraray Castle, home of the Duke of Argyll. Featured in Downton Abbey. We will then go through Kilmartin Glen, where the kings of Scotland were crowned and then onto Loch Melfort. We will check into our hotel and enjoy dinner.

## May 22, 2020:

After breakfast we will visit Kilmartin Glen again and visit the museum. Depending on the weather we will climb Dunadd to see the rock and imprint where St. Columba crowned the first king of Scotland. Afternoon free time in Oban. Dinner at the hotel this evening.

#### May 23, 2020:

After breakfast we will take the ferry to the isle of mull. An hour bus ride from the port of Craignure to Fionnphort where we will take the foot ferry to Iona, site of St. Columba's monastery and his base for spreading Christianity to the pictish kingdoms of Scotland. Dinner and overnight back at Loch Melfort.

#### May 24, 2020:

After breakfast we will drive to Pitlochry in the center of Scotland. We will stop at St. Conan's Church, Dunkeld Cathedral and Fortingal Yew Tree. Dinner at a local restaurant then we will attend a performance at the Pitlochry Festival Theatre. Overnight in Pitlochry.

# May 25, 2020:

After breakfast we will visit Balmoral Castle which is the royal family's highland home and Crathes Kirk where they attend church. Free time in the afternoon to tour Pitlochry. Overnight in Pitlochry.

#### May 26, 2020:

After breakfast we will see Blair Castle, home of the Atholl Highlanders, The UK's only private army, Erdradour the smallest distillery in Scotland and the site of the battle of Killiecrankie. Dinner on own in Pitlochry.

#### May 27, 2020:

After breakfast we will head to Dunfermline our Pittsburgh connection. We will take a walking tour of the town including a visit to Andrew Carnegie's house and museum, Pittencrieff Park, and the Cathedral where Robert the Bruce is buried. After lunch (on own) we will head to Edinburgh for 3 nights. Dinner on own tonight. Overnight in Edinburgh.

#### May 28, 2020:

A free day to explore Edinburgh. Options include: visit the castle, John Knox house, Greyfriar's Church. Dinner on own in Edinburgh.

# May 29, 2020:

After breakfast we will take a tour of St. Giles Cathedral. Afternoon do some last minute shopping. Evening we will attend Jamie's Scottish show and dinner.

#### May 30, 2020:

After breakfast we will take transfer to Edinburgh airport for our flight home to Pittsburgh.
